Our interns have built chatbots, conducted market studies, designed data dashboards, and supported real organizations in solving real problems.

## DIGITAL LITERACY FOR A DIGITAL GENERATION

As the world leans deeper into technology, SADRE continues to lead the conversation on digital literacy and future skills.

The Gen AI Literacy Week at HKBK College transformed every classroom into a creative lab. Students built, explored, and experimented — proving that artificial intelligence isn't just about automation; it's about imagination.

At VBR Degree College, our Gen AI awareness session sparked meaningful discussions on the ethics and opportunities of emerging technologies. These moments reminded us that true digital transformation begins with digital understanding.


